Directions of use;

During the milk feeding phase the aim of the program is to ensure grain consumption by providing unrestricted access to fresh Rex James Calf Grower. This is complimented by free access to straw. Fresh and clean water is essential as water is required for rumen fermentation, calves will not get all the water they need from milk.

Once calves are consistently (three consecutive days) consuming over 1kg of Rex James Calf Grower (0.75kg Jerseys) they are ready for weaning.

Calves should remain housed over weaning and until they reach 10-12 weeks of age. Their intake of Rex James Calf Grower will rapidly increase, so ensuring they have adequate access of fresh starter, straw and water is crucial. At 12 weeks they will be ready to introduce pasture and should be given enough Rex James Calf Grower to maintain desired growth rates.
