Rex James Lamb Finisher contains a balanced combination of rolled cereal grains, legumes, protein meal and a specifically formulated vitamin and mineral premix.

- Contains a rumen buffer(Acid Buff®) to reduce digestive upsets and minimise the risk of acidosis.
- Ionophore (Bovatec®) included for improved feed utilisation and to aid in the prevention of coccidiosis.

Directions of use;

- Ensure good quality, cool and fresh water is available at all times, as clean water is essential for maximising feed intakes.
- Rex James Lamb Finisher should be introduced over a two week period to ensure the rumen has adequate time to adapt.
- To minimise digestive upsets ensure that at least 30% of the ration is roughage
- Ensure access to effective fibre is available at all times

Withholding periods;

Meat: Sheep– Nil

Milk: Sheep– DO NOT USE in lactating ewes where milk products may be used for human consumption.

This Product Contains Bovatec®(Lasalocid Sodium). Do Not allow dogs, horses or other equines access to this feed, as it may be fatal. Avoid sudden changes to the diet in order to prevent digestive problems.
